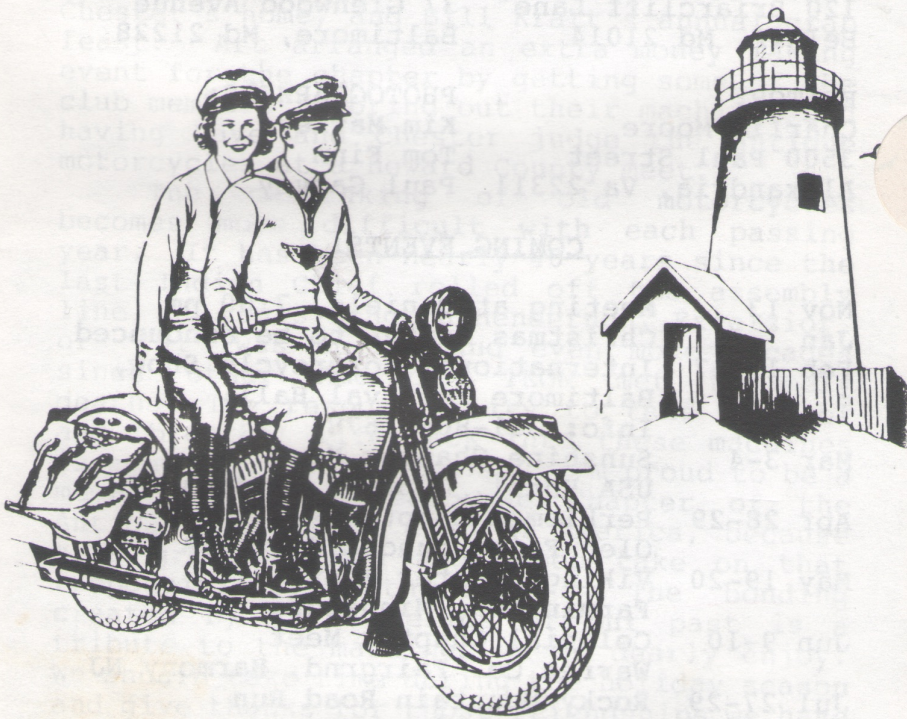

EDITORIAL

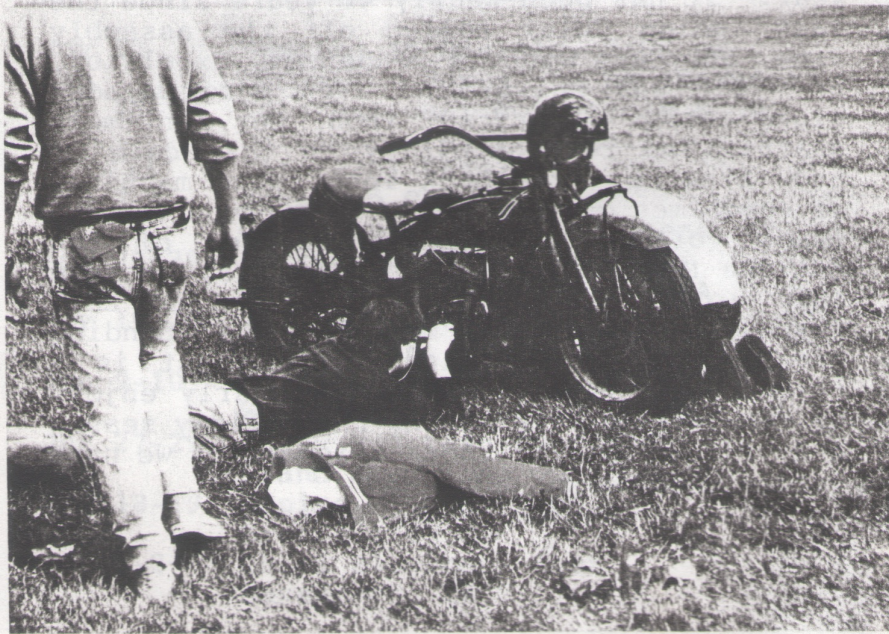
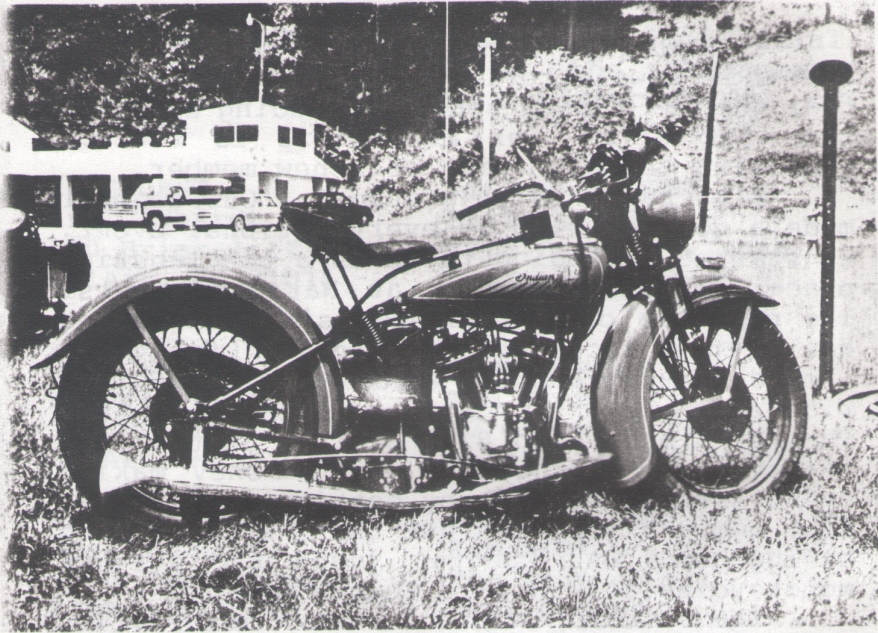
